Ireland: A 10 day cultural exploration

Day 1, Friday March 1 - DEPARTURE

Depart from Brandywine campus at 2:00 PM, to go to Newark airport. Coach transfer is included.

5:00 PM Check-in at United Airline counter at terminal C.

7:45 PM Flight UA#23 leaves for Dublin.

Day 2, Saturday March 2 - DUBLIN

7:00 AM Assistance and transfer upon arrival in Dublin. Go to the hotel and leave your luggage in storage. Proceed for an orientation tour of Dublin to be acquainted to the city and most landmarks of the capital of Ireland. Part of the tour will be walking. Your guide will explain local currency and custom. Tour will end when it is time to check-in at the hotel which could be as late as 3:00 PM
Remainder of the day free to rest or investigate the city of Dublin.

Day 3, Sunday March 3 - DUBLIN (B)

Day in Dublin for academic studies.

Day 4, Monday March 4 - DUBLIN-BELFAST (B)

At 9:00 AM leave Dublin and Ireland for Northern Ireland and Belfast, 104 miles

11:00 AM Arrival in Belfast and check-in at hotel. You may have to leave your luggage in storage till rooms are ready. Check-in time can be as late as 3:00 PM.

You will need a different currency and will use English pounds for 2 days versus euros.

Afternoon city tour of Belfast including West Belfast and the murals.

Rest of the afternoon for academic studies.

Day 5, Tuesday March 5 - BELFAST (B)

Day in Belfast for your academic studies.

Should your academic duties allow, optional day excursion to the Giant Causeway (Price:

\$90). The legend says that Irish giant Fionn Mac Cumhaill (Finn McCool) created the

causeway to travel to Scotland and fight his rival Benandonner, but came back smartish

when he saw how big he was.

Day 6, Wednesday March 6 - BELFAST-GALWAY (B)

At 8:00 AM depart by coach to return to Ireland. Morning drive.

2:00 PM E.T.A. Check-in at hotel for 2 nights

Afternoon in Galway for academic studies.

Day 7, Thursday March 7 - GALWAY (B)

Day in Galway for academic studies.

Should Academic duties allow, optional Half day excursion to Connemara National Park, a

vast expanse of mountains, bogs, heathland and lakes, all forming a beautiful and unique

scenery. (Price: \$50)

Day 8, Friday March 8 - GALWAY-LIMERICK (B)

At 9:00 AM depart from Galway. Drive to Limerick: 62 miles, 1h ½ (10:00 AM E.T.A.).

Check-in a hotel in Limerick - luggage may be left in storage till check-in time

Day for academic studies in Limerick.

Day 9, Saturday March 9 - LIMERICK (B, D)

Full day excursion to the Burren National Park and the Cliff of Moher.

The cliffs run for nearly 9 miles along the coast of the Atlantic Ocean. At the South end they rise 390 ft above the water and, five miles to the North, they reach their maximum height of 702 ft. Evening farewell dinner and traditional entertainment at the Locke Bar, (or similar).

Day 10, Sunday March 10 - RETURN (B)

9:30 AM Depart from hotel

10:15 AM Check-in at United counter at Shannon airport

12:30 PM Departure from Shannon

3:05 PM Arrival Newark. Meet your driver to return by coach to Brandywine campus

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Everyone needs a passport valid until July 10, 2019. If you are not an American citizen, a visa may be required, a Green Card or equivalent is compulsory.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

A deposit of \$500 is due upon registration.

When registration is made within 60 days prior to departure, full amount of the trip is due.

CANCELLATIONS, PENALTIES, AND FEES

All changes and cancellations must be provided in writing. The following penalties apply with the number of days prior to departure:

- \$350 if cancellation is received between **November 28 - December 27, 2018**, + processing fee of \$150: Total \$500 penalty
- 50% of the total trip cost between **December 28, 2018 - January 15, 2019**
- 100% of the total trip cost within after **January 15** or in case of no-show
