CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS FOR STUDENT VOICES

Students from all disciplines are invited to submit original work to the Student Voices section of *JCES*. All forms of writing, analysis, creative approaches, and methodologies are acceptable for the journal. Specific types of submissions appropriate for the Student Voices section include commentaries, critical reflections, and opinion pieces related to community engagement and/or engaged scholarship. Given that engagement scholarship is an interdisciplinary field in which all appropriate ways to best "tell the story" are not known, scholarly contributions of all kinds related to the field of engagement scholarship are welcome and will be considered for publication in *JCES*.

Student Voices submissions are accepted on an ongoing basis. Manuscripts should be 750–2,000 words in length.
